Our classic Best Bitter. Brewed with Bobek hops, this ale is full of flavour and deliciously moorish.



An excellent pale ale with a light, clean and refreshing character.



An Extra Special Bitter, our Daughter is dark and dangerous with chocolate notes.



A light porter, rich, smooth bodied and extremely quaffable.



Our Brewer's twist on the well hopped IPA.

The strongest of our ales, this Russian Imperial Stout is soft, smooth and mellow.



A SmaSH (Single Malt and Single Hop) pale ale that is biscuity in flavour with a slight citrus hop finish.



A winter seasonal special, this old ale includes cocoa nibs for a truly decadent beer.



A summer seasonal special, this tropical pale ale is fruity and refreshing, perfect for a warm summer day.



Originally brewed as the 33rd East Anglian Beer & Cider Festival's festive, this pale ale has flavours of stone fruit that combines with a wonderful creamy mouthfeel.



Dancing Molly is named after some plucky petticoated pirates and brings flavours as bold as those pirates were. Hopped in kettle with Solero and dry hopped with Mosaic, this ale brings a full on tropical punch in this modern ale.
